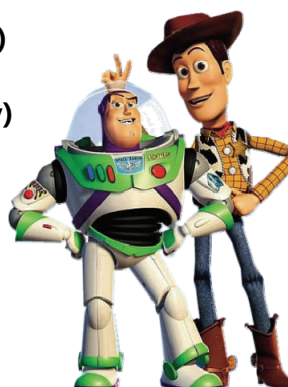

Guest of Honour: Drew Sullivan

Drew Sullivan is currently captain of the Mersey Tigers Basketball Squad. The Mersey Tigers were National winners in 2011. Drew is also Captain of the GB National Basketball Squad. In 1999 Drew enrolled at the university of Villa Nova he joined the Faculty of Arts and Science. Drew graduated in 2003. Villa Nova University is the home of the Wild Cats Basketball Team and Drew was the Novas most versatile defender. Drew established himself as Villa Novas best defensive player and was the only squad member to play all 32 games in the season.

Drew left Villa Nova University in 2003 and signed a Professional Basketball Contract with Dutch Club Nijmegen. Drew subsequently signed for Newcastle Eagles who won the Championship Playoffs in 2005. Drew was the highest scorer in the final with 27 points and named "most valuable player". In 2006 Drew was named British Basketballs Player of the Year.

Drew then signed for Joventut Badaloma in the Elite Euro League. In the summer of 2010 Drew signed for the Mersey tigers and again won National Honours in 2011.

Drew competed in the 2006 Commonwealth Games in Melbourne where England won the Bronze Medal. Drew has also played for the GB National Team competing in the European Games in 2009.
